## Editorial: Healings (again?)

Time, and time again we come up against “special” ways to overcome a particular sickness and/or the “perfect” way to get a victory over a particular problem.

I believe most, if not all of these get far too complicated and they don't seem to have more or better results than the way we have been going about these things now for a great number of years.

I came across a quote recently, as follows:

*“Amplify God in your life and the problems get smaller”.* My translation of this is: *“The larger God gets in our life, the smaller the problems get”.*

A bit like the pictures below...



Interestingly, looking the “**right**” way (through binoculars) magnifies the problem and looking the “**wrong**” way, makes it look smaller.

And that is exactly the way it is, we are programmed, in our mind that the worldly way is the right way, and that is not true.

Another quote: *“every solution which has our self-central, is not a real solution”.*

The above comes from the current world view that ‘nice’ is the same as ‘good’.

In the first verses of Mark 9 we read about the transfiguration of Jesus. In verse 5 we read: *And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.*

Here the word ‘good’ means, among other things, it is ‘meet’ or it is good we are here so we can...

So, Peter had a ‘good’ idea...

In contrast we read in Mark 10:18, the words of Jesus: *‘And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God’.*

Here, the word ‘good’ means absolute correct, perfect and complete.

And that is precisely where our victories come from.

In Titus 1:2 we read: *‘... which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began’.*

Now we all know the numerous promises in the Bible. And we know that God cannot lie. And we know that He is perfect, we KNOW... lots of things.

*1Jo 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.*

*1Jo 5:15 And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.*

*1Jo 5:18 We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.*

*1Jo 5:19 And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness.*

*1Jo 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him*

*that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.*

So, what do we need to do to live life to the MAX? (as the saying goes.)

Like in the book of Job, Chapter 42, Job gets the idea of how great God really is, and the victory follows.

In the same way, all our victories lay in doing our homework, being where the action is, at the meetings, conventions, outreaches, camps, discovering and re-discovering daily, how great God really is.

Being filled with wonder and amazement that this God, gave us His Holy Spirit, to enable us to travel this road of discoveries, more and more, further and further, till eternal life..

## Dordrecht, NL

We started this month with a dinner & quiz night with a few visitors. The following week five saints shared their testimony at our signs and wonders evening. A sister shared how God provided her with a house in a miraculous way; out of 936 people she got the house.


